Interactive activity designed to encourage rigorous ethical decision making. Developed by Nottingham University, originally as an online activity, it is now available as a pdf. Students evaluate the rights and wrongs of organic vs intensive farming of hens, pigs and salmon from the viewpoint of various interest groups and values.



## GAP: Pig Welfare

Book, film and PowerPoint resources designed for agricultural and veterinary college students but suitable for schools with farms.



## Stimulus Response DVD

This short film by the Association for the Study of Animal Behaviour uses delightful animal stories to teach the nervous system and animal behaviour. It is suitable for GCSE and A-level Science and Psychology.

### Let's Ask the Animals DVD & teachers' pack

This remarkable film, made by the Association for the Study of Animal Behaviour, teaches the needs of animals using many of the same stories as in Stimulus Response. Hens learn from watching TV; piglets show how they benefit from enriched environments; sheep show their maternal instincts and learn to tell motor vehicles apart. This film has children aged 7-11 entranced for 20 minutes.

This DVD and teachers' pack is free to primary schools. It can be accompanied by a complimentary copy of the Farm Animals & Us DVD for children aged 10 and above to encourage discussion about the rights and the wrongs of intensive animal farming.
